Face it, the last couple of years have worn us all down. Sometimes we don't know how to pray, or we don't seem to find the words we want. It is easy to falter and waver. Lent is a time to get back to the basics. There is much hope and strength in our readings as we begin our Lenten journey. The letter to the Romans tells us today that "everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved," and this is an idea we hear throughout the scriptures. Psalm 91 shows us exactly how to cry for help, "Be with me, Lord, when I am in trouble." In Deuteronomy, Moses teaches the people to bring their first fruit offerings to God, and put their faith and trust in God, and Jesus teaches us in today's Gospel that we find our life in the word of God.

Good Zeal and Temptations

In the chapter of Luke preceding today's Gospel, Jesus was baptized in the Jordan and began his adult ministry. Immediately afterward he was led by the Spirit into the desert to be tested. While this might seem almost surreal as we imagine the devil taking Jesus from place to place, it is really much more simple and common than that. For many of us, as we

strive to live our lives, we deal with many temptations. Sometimes it is a matter of having the zeal and desire, but not the practical experience or knowledge to carry out a goal. Other times, we are afraid to ask for the assistance that we need to carry a project through to completion. Or we might think that we deserve more, or that our results should be happening more quickly. Our egos can be destructive.



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Knowing Your Touchstones

When Jesus found himself tested by the devil, he was given several different scenarios. The devil brought up situations that he knew could specifically test Jesus, but similar situations would test any of us. Physical hunger is a real need, and many of us might yearn for success, or better paying jobs, or power, or the like. The difference is that when Jesus was tempted, he had some strong “touchstones” to hold onto, secure answers to lead him. He went to simple, basic scriptures that he could call upon in his time of need. For many, one of those basics would be Jeremiah, “I know the plans I have in mind for you—plans for peace and not disaster.” For another it might be the Beatitudes or the twenty-third Psalm. Whatever it may be, have ready those touchstones, those “go to” prayers or phrases that you can hold onto during the times when you are sorely tested in your life. Let those stones be your firm foundation.

Conociendo tus referentes

Cuando Jesús se encontró con la prueba del diablo, se le dieron varios escenarios diferentes. El diablo planteó situaciones que sabía que podían poner a prueba a Jesús, pero situaciones similares nos pondrían a prueba a cualquiera de nosotros. El hambre física es una necesidad real, y muchos de nosotros podemos anhelar el éxito, o un trabajo mejor pagado, o el poder, o cosas similares. La diferencia es que cuando Jesús fue tentado, tenía algunos “referentes” fuertes a las que aferrarse, respuestas seguras para guiarlo. Acudió a pasajes de las Escrituras sencillas y básicas a las que podía recurrir en su momento de necesidad. Para muchos, uno de esos fundamentos sería Jeremías: “Yo sé los planes que tengo para ti: planes de paz y no de desastre”. Para otro, podrían ser las Bienaventuranzas o el salmo 23. Sea lo que sea, ten preparadas esos referentes, esas oraciones o frases “imprescindibles” a las que puedes aferrarte en los momentos en que tu vida sea sometida a una dura prueba. Deja que esos referentes sean tu fundamento firme.



Treasures from the St. Pius V Archives February 14, 2016

"A Time to Make Decisions"

The image for the first Sunday of Lent is of Jesus going off by himself into the desert to fast and pray as he prepares to begin his public ministry of teaching and healing. For the Jews, the desert was where to go to seek God. It was wild, barren, and free of distractions—the perfect place to seek and find the direction of the work the Father had given them.

After his baptism, Jesus goes into the wilderness so as to hear more clearly the voice of the Father. But, there is also another voice present; that of the adversary, who would do anything to disrupt the communication between the Son and the Father. In the three temptations, Jesus must decide how his words and actions will help make his mission be understood by others.

Our Lent—time of decisions: *In the desert, Jesus sought the direction and form of his life. Each year, lent gives us an opportunity to search our lives and make decisions about which direction we would like to go into the future. Waiting at the end of lent are Holy Week and Easter. While we might know the stories, we might not have probed the depths of what these might mean to our faith, and the fate of the history of the world. Even more importantly, we might not have allowed the risen Christ into our hearts to the point that the orientation of our lives and our decisions that direct it conform to the faith in Christ that we profess.*

Like Jesus in the desert, we too, have other voices that tempt us to make decisions that are contrary to our Christian faith. These voices urge that the sinful practices and institutions which are contrary to gospel values, continue to dominate the world. In our Lenten practices, we reinforce our understanding of faith and gain the strength and discipline to have a firm purpose as followers of Christ. May each Lenten decision be a step that brings us closer to Easter joy.

Tesoros de los archivos de San Pío V 14 de febrero 2016:

"Llamados para proclamar a Dios"

La imagen del primer domingo de cuaresma es Jesús yendo sólo al desierto para ayunar y orar mientras se prepara para su misión pública de la educación y la sanación. Para los judíos, el desierto es un lugar donde puede encontrarse con Dios. Es un lugar salvaje y de tierra árida, sin distracciones—un lugar idóneo para buscar y encontrar el camino que Dios había marcado para ellos.

Después de su bautismo, Jesús va a un lugar solitario para escuchar más claramente la voz del Padre. Pero, hay otra voz presente, la del adversario, un ser que daría todo su esfuerzo para interrumpir esa conversación entre el Padre y el Hijo. En las tres tentaciones, Jesús tiene que decidir cómo puede comunicar a otros, mediante sus palabras y acciones- en que consiste su misión.

La cuaresma—tiempo de decidir: En el desierto, Jesús buscó la dirección y la forma de su vida. Cada año, la cuaresma nos da una oportunidad para buscar cual dirección de la vida estamos tomando, y que dirección queremos tomar en el futuro. Al final de cada cuaresma tenemos Semana Santa y la Pascua. Aun muchos conocemos los datos, otros no hemos probado la riqueza del sentido espiritual y su capacidad no sólo de transformar vidas, sino también cambiar la trayectoria de la historia del mundo. Más importante, a nivel personal, no hemos permitido que Cristo resucitado entre en nuestros corazones y oriente nuestras decisiones y nuestras vidas para conforme a la suya.

Como Cristo en el desierto, hay otras voces tentándonos tomar decisiones contrarias a los principios de nuestra fe cristiana. Aquellas voces desean que el pecado y las instituciones corruptas sigan dominando al mundo. Por nuestras prácticas cuaresmales, reforzamos nuestra comprensión de la fe, y ganamos la fuerza y la disciplina de tener un propósito firme en ser seguidores de Cristo. Que cada decisión cuaresmal, sea un paso que nos lleva más cerca al gozo pascual.

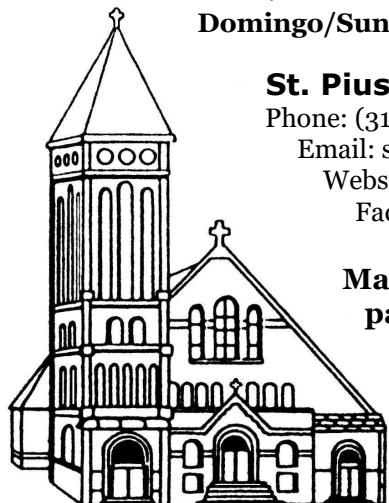


